GENERAL:

Face Masks and/or face shields may be required independently or worn together depending on current directives. Outside singing 6 or more feet apart may not require face covering, depending on current directives. Inside singing 6 feet or more apart indoors will require face coverings, depending on current directives. ENTRY

- SIGNED LIABILITY WAIVER REQUIRED FOR ALL PARTICIPANTS
- ENTRY DENIED IF YOU ARE SICK (fever, symptomatic display)
- SCS SCHEDULED IN PERSON EVENTS ARE CANCELLED and immediate alterations from on-site to virtual rehearsal will occur if/when a governing body of legal authority orders.
- SELF-QUARANTINE (do not attend SCS event(s)) expected as indicated by current Ohio mandate(s) for persons who have travelled to designated self-quarantine destinations.

HEALTH AND SAFETY STRATEGIES - POSTED

- Temperatures taken at the door
- Hand-sanitizer station on every floor
- Masks and/or face shields (depending on current mandates) to be worn indoors as current mandates dictate.
- Outdoor music may not include masks and/or face shields with social distancing, as directed.
- Doors/windows propped open when available
- Rooms cleaned after student groups dismissed
- Air filtration units clean and orderly.
- Hand sanitizer stations / glove stations
- Socially distancing observed
- Separate entrances for each choir
- Limit visit – no parents *Health/safety exceptions made
- No SCS events will be held during open hours for Summit Artspace.
- Staggered entry/exit / pathways / times
