ONLINE FORMS TO FILL OUT

1) Minor Child Travel Consent Form (All singers)

2) Student Medical Release Form (All singers)

-All medications and prescriptions must be in original their containers and listed on the Student Medical Release for singers to self-administer. Please take note of travel times and differentiate between what medications need to be taken during travel, as these should be packed in the students personal item.

3) Independent Traveler Form (must be completed if singer is not on the group flight, both ways)

4) Breakfast Selection Form (All singers)

5) Dinner Selection Form (All singers)

ITINERARY –A live itinerary is shared with updates and changes live on the Tour Page.

-Pack one personal item (small backpack, purse/under the seat on airplane, (18 x 14 x 8)

-Pack one carry-on suitcase (overhead bin on airplane, max: 24 inches in length, (22 x 14 x 9)

-iPads distributed at CLE upon arrival. Please leave room in your carry on or personal item for your iPad.

-All students are responsible for carrying their own luggage.

-All bags must be clearly labeled with singers name.

- Extra glasses / contacts / contact solution
- Money for lunches
